

**EMERGENCY MOTION AGREED BY AUTUMN CONFERENCE 2023** 

## **Protecting Our Rivers**

## **Conference notes:**

- A. Dwr Cymru has admitted to illegally spilling untreated sewage across Wales for years.
- B. Figures show that Dwr Cymru has between 40 and 50 wastewater treatment plants operating in breach of their permits.
- C. Figures show that 6 out of the top 10 areas across the UK for sewage discharges in 2022 were in Wales.
- D. Dwr Cymru bosses have received £2.6m between 2020-2022, including £931m in performance related bonuses.
- E. Dwr Cymru customers have the second highest bills in England and Wales.

Conference regrets the failure of the Welsh Labour Government to take action on river pollution and sewage infrastructure across the country.

## Conference calls on the Welsh Government to:

- 1. Launch independent and comprehensive review of the performance and operation of Dwr Cymru.
- 2. End performance-related bonuses for company bosses at least until performance improves relative to Natural Resources Wales and Ofwat ratings.
- 3. Pass tougher regulations on sewage dumping, including tougher sanctions and penalties for instances of sewage discharges and illegal sewage dumping.
